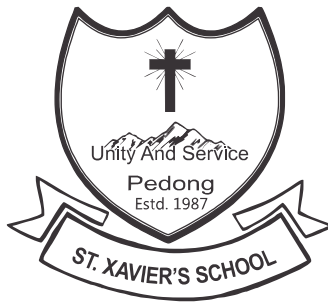

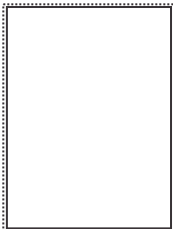

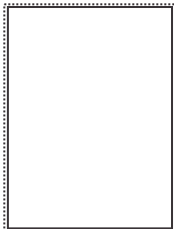

# St. Francis Xavier

Patron of the School

*He was born in Spain in the year 1506. He was one of the first companions of Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus. When he was studying at Paris he joined Saint Ignatius and was ordained Priest at Rome in 1537. He was a great professor in the University of Paris, proud, self centered, conscious of his own intellectual abilities. As soon as Ignatius met him, he showed a special admiration and affection for him. He found in Francis Xavier a spark of greatness and generosity hidden under the fire this man by the famous saying "What does it profit to a man to gain the whole world and then lose his soul." Those words inflamed him to follow courageously the way to God under the leadership of Ignatius.*

*He spent himself in works of charity and in 1541, he went to the East, where for ten years he preached the Gospel in India and Japan and brought many to the true faith. He started the first Jesuit School in India. He died in the year 1552 on the Chinese island of Shangchwan. Later on his body was brought back to Goa. Now it is the Bom Jesus Church situated in Old Goa. On the 3rd of December, the Catholic Church celebrates this great Saint's Feast Day.*

*He is one of the Patron Saints of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny. St. Xavier's School, Pedong is named after him. We pray to him that we experience many blessings through his intercession.*



# St. Xavier's School Pedong

St. Xavier's School, Pedong established in 1987 is a unit of St. Xavier's Educational Trust. The School is recognized by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education and is affiliated to ICSE and ISC, New Delhi. It is a minority Christian School under the jurisdiction of the Roman Catholic Bishop of Darjeeling and is managed and administered by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny.

Set against the picturesque backdrop of paddy fields, serpentine rivers and snow capped mountains, St. Xavier's provides an ideal atmosphere for an all round growth and development of its pupils.

St. Xavier's aims at the integral formation of the young. To accomplish this it endeavours to create an environment which generates a love of learning, habits of critical thought and accurate expression and the strength of character and moral values needed for life that is socially meaningful. Therefore efforts are made to teach the students:

- To be unselfish in love and in the service of their fellow men/women.
- To be agents of needed social change in their country.
- To be clear and firm on principles and courageous action.
- To value and judiciously use their freedom.
- To be mature, spiritually oriented men and women of character.
- To strive continually after excellence in every field physical, emotional, mental, aesthetic, moral, social and spiritual

## **Academic Session and School Timing:**

The School year is divided into three terms, namely:

1. First Term : February to May
2. Second Term : June to September
3. Third Term : October to Mid December

### **Important Rules:**

1. This calendar must be brought to school every day.
2. Student must be on time for school. They must be neatly dressed in the prescribed school uniform. Those coming to school wearing designer belts, shoes or fancy carrings will be sent back home. **Dyeing of hair strictly forbidden.**
3. **English will be spoken at all times in the school premises.**
4. Pupils should be in the school compound during recesses.
5. The school is not responsible for any pupil before and after school hours.
6. Pupils should not go out of the school compound during class hours without the permission of the Principal or the Sister-in-charge.
7. For pupils intending to join school elsewhere Transfer Certificate will be issued only after the commencement of the new academic year i.e. in March.
8. The possession and use of cell phones, i-pods is strictly forbidden. If it is found with the students, **it will be confiscated and never be returned.**
9. Check frequently on the children's attendance and behaviour by duly signing leave notes and remarks.
10. Regular hair cut for boys is to checked by the parents/no hair style will be allowed.
11. Any word leave the School in the middle of the session he/she has to pay the full amount of Fees for the whole Academic session.

11. Kindly sign the for the marks entered for the unit test in order to check the progress of your ward. Parent-Teacher meetings are compulsory after each term.
12. Co Curricular Activities are essential part of School Activities & all around development of a child. Kindly ensure your children participate in guiding / scouts, school outings & games / sports / tournaments.
13. **Students are not allowed to go to home during lunch break; they can either bring their Tiffin or buy things from the school canteen.**
14. See the children study daily at home, complete the lessons and assignments which will be written in the students diary.
15. Sign against the children remarks column for the unit tests and terminal examination report.
16. Note the daily routine provided in the school diary and make sure the children take the required text books an copies to school.
17. Ensure that children who arrive late have their diaries signed by the Principal or in her absence by the Sister-in Charge.
18. **Note that you are permitted to meet the Class teacher or the subject teacher only before or after class hours.**
19. Attend the parent/teacher meeting held at the end of each term to discuss the progress of your children.
20. Student involved in fights, gang fights will be suspended or even expelled depending on the magnitude of the offence.
21. **Regarding Admission we do not ask any donation.**

#### **Awarding of Prizes:**

Prizes are awarded annually for excellence in academics and in the field of sports for courtesy, helpfulness, and neatness. The

"Xaverian of the Year" award is given to the pupil who excels both in academics and sports and displays the basic virtues of a student.

### **Examination and promotion.**

Besides Class Tests which will be conducted every week in the first and second terms, examinations will be held at the end of every term. Please note that a student, who fails to appear for his/her Annual Examination due to medical reason, is not eligible for promotion to a higher class unless he/she has passed the Tests and the previous examination.

Promotion depends on the student's performance throughout the year, not merely on marks scored in the final examination.

**There is no system of re-examination or reconsideration of a student who has not been promoted.** Do not pressurize the authorities either through influential people or social/political organizations. This does not help the student in his/her future career.

### **Promotion Criteria:**

- a. Pass marks for all students in all subjects is 35%.
- b. A student who does not obtain 40% in English or Mathematics is considered a failure.
- c. A student who fails in two or more subjects is considered failed.
- d. **No division or rank will be awarded to a student who fails in any subjects.**
- e. If the student is absent for the Test or Term **he/she will not appear for it at later days.**
- f. **Students who fail for two consecutive years cannot remain in the school.**
- g. Average of Test and term examination will be taken for promotion.

## Fees

- a. **Tuition fees must be paid for 12 months a year, irrespective of when the student is admitted to/withdrawn from the school.**
- b. Fees should be paid regularly every month to ensure that the institution runs smoothly.
- c. Last date of paying fees and miscellaneous expenses is the 20<sup>th</sup> day of each month. A fine of 10 per day will be charged on fees paid later than the prescribed date.
- d. **Children will not be allowed to sit for the examinations and will not be given the Progress Report if the fees are not paid by the prescribed dates.**

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS**

### **Parents are to heed to the following guidelines :**

- Parents are requested not to discuss School matters with any teacher during School hours. Parents who want information or wish to discuss any problem relating to the School, **should contact the Principal (not the class teacher) at the appointed time on School days only.**
- Excuse for absence and late attendance should not be made by phone but in writing in the diary.
- After an illness a pupil must produce a doctor's certificate stating that she/he is fit to join School;
- Parents are requested to keep children at home, who feel feverish or otherwise ill, even if it means missing a test.
- Parents are to check the diary regularly for remarks by the teacher regarding academic progress, behavior, neglect of home assignments and for the weekly unit test result.
- Once the child comes to school she/he can go home at the end of the school hours. Parents are not allowed to take their ward back during school hours unless and until there is an emergency.
- In emergency written permission must be taken from the Principal/ Sister-in-Charge.
- Should there be any legitimate complaints, please meet the Principal or Sister-in-Charge at the earliest or write to her.
- Any communication made by the parents/guardian should be addressed to the Principal. The name, address and phone number, class and section of the child should be clearly mentioned in the application.

### **THE METHOD OF STUDY**

All of you have to devote a lot of time to your studies but most of you it impossible to finish the given task or assignments. From where then can you find time to study? For this there is no magic formula but the formation of Correct study habits. This will keep you free from anxiety and give a feeling of confidence.

#### ***I. Study conditions***

1. Avoid all distractions: Do not let your mind Wander or be distracted from What you are doing. For this, select a quiet place.
2. Keep ready all materials you might require close at hand so that you do not waste time and energy looking for it.
3. Study under proper light, for poor light tires the eyes and you lose concentration.
4. Have proper ventilation, for fresh air keeps the mind alert.

## ***II. Make a plan for study***

1. Keep in mind what you have to study, how much you have to study and time you have. Have a balance between leisure and study. Organise a time-table in such a way that you have fun and sufficient time for study.
2. Decide when to study and what to study. Make a weekly time table. It is better to have a short frequent period for each subject than long hours for one. Start with interesting easy lessons/topics and then go on to difficult ones unless they are interconnected.
3. Pay total attention to what you are studying: You will absorb more and understand better.
4. Do not study when you are tired. Relax with something light for a short while and come back to studies. But do not confuse laziness and tiredness.
5. Understand the material you have to learn as a whole.
6. Re-learn and revise previous lessons frequently. If you have learnt mathematical formula or grammar rules practice their use for, practice makes it perfect.
7. Do not try to learn everything by heart. Read the chapter carefully, understand the ideas and write the essential points.
8. Do not learn notes but get the most important points and put them down in order headings and sub-headings.
9. During the weekend, set aside sometime to go, over the week's work Concentrating on points you had not grasped.
